*Arrive on frequency about 5 minutes early to make sure frequency is clear. You may announce your presence and take early check-ins if you want. If you are running the logger as well, create the net and open it at this time and monitor AIM. You may also want to put any pertinent information up on AIM.*

### **7:30pm net starts**

Good evening and welcome to the Hancock Auxcomm Team 2 meter simplex net.  
This net meets every Thursday at 7:30pm local time.

*Go ahead and start running the net once check ins are done. After running the net take another look for check ins. Also a good point to designate a relay during the net, try to use the farthest station that you can still copy good enough as a relay. After all check ins have had a turn and no more check ins are coming in close the net. Also very important if you are running netlogger you must close the net in netlogger as well.*
